Photography and use of images policy

In accordance with the requirements of Section 11 (1) of the Children First Act 2015 we have undertaken an assessment of any potential for harm to a child while availing of our services. The risk is of abuse and not general health and safety risk. This risk assessment considers the potential for harm to come to children whilst they are in the Club's care.

Reason for this policy

Certain of the identified risks can be addressed by appropriate policies.

Young people should not be photographed or videoed except in accordance with the consent of the person with parental responsibility for them. No photography may take place in changing rooms or bathrooms.

Policy


It is the policy of Blackrock Tennis Club that young people should not be photographed or videoed without a detailed consent form signed by the person with parental responsibility for them and that still or video images of young people taken in Blackrock Tennis Club should only be used strictly in accordance with that consent. Any consent form should be pre-approved by the Children's Officers and by the Data Privacy Manager. No photography may take place in changing rooms or bathrooms.

Responsibility

Responsibility for understanding and compliance and for maintaining records of compliance with this policy rests with (a) the Junior Tennis Committee and (b) anyone charged by the Junior Tennis Committee with organization or supervision of any event or activity involving young people.
